## Purpose of this guide

This guide provides researchers with step-by-step instructions for linking their Open Researcher and Contributor ID (ORCID) profile to their Canada Foundation for Innovation (CFI) Awards Management System (CAMS) profile. It includes details on the different functionalities available after the profiles are linked, such as importing and exporting information.

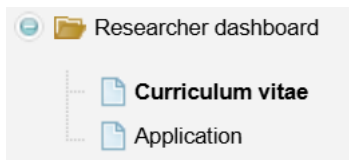
## Linking your ORCID profile to your CAMS profile

There are two ways you can link your ORCID profile to your CAMS profile:

- From your CAMS Curriculum vitae
- Directly from your CAMS profile.

### Linking your ORCID profile to your CAMS profile from your CAMS Curriculum vitae

1. Sign into CAMS.
2. Click “Researcher dashboard” on the top left of the screen.
3. Click “Curriculum vitae.”




4. Click the “Link ORCID” button.

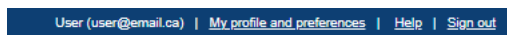

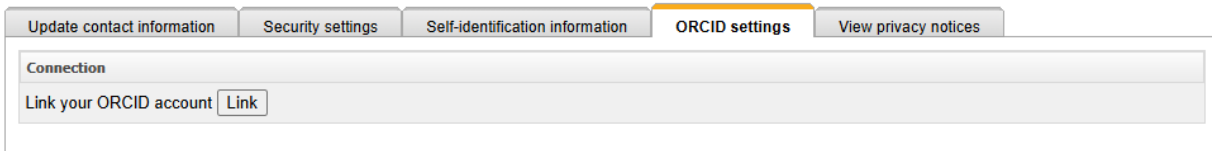

## Troubleshooting

Some common problems that may arise when linking your ORCID profile to your CAMS profile are:

- If your ORCID profile is already associated with a CAMS profile, you will not be able to link your ORCID profile to another CAMS profile.
- If your browser is already signed in to ORCID, you will need to sign out of ORCID before linking your ORCID profile to your CAMS profile. You can sign out of ORCID from the top right of the [ORCID website](#).

## Importing information from your ORCID profile to your CAMS CV

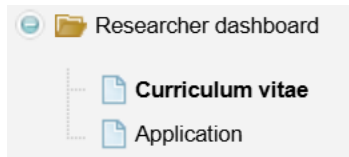
There are two ways you can import from your ORCID profile to your CAMS CV:

- From your CAMS Curriculum vitae
- Directly from your CAMS profile.

**ORCID/CAMS fields do not match perfectly. Be sure to review what has been imported before you submit a notice of intent or application. See Appendix A for details on ORCID – CAMS mapping.**

### Important import notes

- The fields in ORCID do not match the fields in CAMS perfectly (see Appendix A: Mapping ORCID fields to CAMS fields). Review and correct the imported information before you submit your notice of intent or funding proposal.
- The “Funding” section of the CAMS CV allows for a maximum of 10 (latest) records to be imported and the “Work experience” section allows a maximum of 15 (latest) records to be imported. The “Academic background” section has no limit on the number of records imported.
- Only the “Education” records are imported from the “Education and Qualification” section in ORCID into the CAMS “Academic background” section.
- Records are imported (newest first) based on the “Added” date from ORCID and sorted (newest first) on the screen or PDF in CAMS based on the date associated to the record (e.g., “Academic background” uses “Date received or expected” field to sort).

### Exporting information from CAMS to ORCID

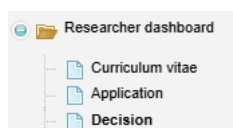
From CAMS, you can export a record for current and past awards as well as a record of review recognition for having participated in the peer review process, to your ORCID profile. NOTE: This is only for reviews completed after June 30, 2026.

### Exporting awards to ORCID

The CFI publishes award information on the CFI website (Innovation.ca) as well as an award Digital Object Identifier (DOI). If you decide to export a record of your award to your ORCID profile, the CFI award DOI is updated to include your ORCID identifier.

If you are a project leader (administrative) on a project, you will be able to indicate the award records you want to export to your ORCID profile on the “Decision” screen.

4. Click “Yes” under “Flag for ORCID export.” If you select “Yes,” your award record will be available on your ORCID profile when the funding decision is released to the public. 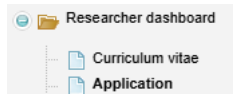

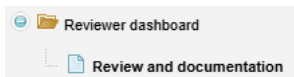

## Export review recognition to ORCID

If you have participated in a peer review committee you can receive a recognition record to your ORCID profile from CAMS for having done a review. You will be able to indicate if you want to receive your recognition record to your ORCID profile on the committee screen. To preserve reviewer anonymity, the recognition record that is exported to ORCID contains no project/competition/committee specific information.

1. Sign into CAMS.
2. Click “Reviewer dashboard” on the top left of the screen.
3. Click “Review and documentation.”



4. Select the committee from which you want to export the recognition record.
5. Click “Yes” under “Flag for ORCID export.” If you select “Yes,” your recognition record will be available on your ORCID profile once your review is completed and the project funding decision has been released. If the project funding decision has already been released, your recognition record will be available on your ORCID profile within 24 hours.

3. Navigate to the “ORCID settings” tab.
4. Click the “Unlink” button. This will Unlink your CAMS profile from your ORCID profile.
5. Follow the instructions on the ORCID website under [“Revoking permission”](#) to revoke the permission to CAMS.

## Appendix B – Frequently asked questions

### **Can I link my ORCID profile to more than one CAMS profile?**

No, CAMS only allows a one-to-one relationship between ORCID and CAMS profiles.

### **Does CAMS save more than one version of my CAMS CV?**

No, CAMS only saves one version of your CAMS CV. The import from ORCID will overwrite what you had previously written in your CAMS CV, so if needed, save the previous version in PDF format before you complete the import.

### **Once I import my ORCID information into the CAMS CV, can I revert the import?**

No, there are no backup versions of the CAMS CV available. The import from ORCID will overwrite what you had previously written in your CAMS CV, so if needed, save the previous version in PDF format before you complete the import.

### **Does CAMS update information I have exported to my ORCID profile after the export?**

No, once information has been exported to ORCID, it is not updated.

### **What is a Digital Object Identifier?**
